Project: File Folders  
Title: Finally Organized Files  
Skill Level: Beginner to Intermediate

## Description:

These fun folders can be used to keep all those school papers organized. Make as many folders as you think you'll need and label them any way you want. Find a cute box to store them in and you are ready to go! Then, at the end of the year (or semester) you can go through the folders and decide which papers are keepers. Put the folders right into your scrapbook at the end of the year!

## Directions:

1. Choose patterned papers to cover file folders. (I used expandable file folders, but regular ones can be used too.)
2. Trim front patterned paper to fit front of folder. Approximately: 11 5/8" x 9".
3. To cut out notches at top: Lightly adhere paper to folder, turn upside down and trace cut out outline onto back of patterned paper. Then remove paper, cut out lines, and adhere securely.
4. Choose a coordinating patterned paper for the top of the inside of the folder. *Don't forget about solids on backsides of patterns.*
5. Cut paper to approximately 11 5/8's x 2". Round top corners with corner rounder punch.
6. Slide paper into top of folder and adhere.
7. Punch circles from same paper as used on top portion of folder. Adhere in center of folder with a pop dot. Add a Chipboard Shape to the circle.
8. Repeat steps above for all folders.
9. Once all folders are covered, choose a paper to create tabs on top.
10. Punch circles from chosen paper and adhere to top of each folder. Only put adhesive on bottom portion of circle.
11. Add text to circle labels by using School Days Titles rub-ons and 3D Publisher stickers.
12. Add a Softies clip to each folder to help keep papers organized.

Project: Journal  
Title: Scholarly Journal  
Skill Level: Beginner

### Description:

Embellish a cute School Days journal just for your scholar! If your student is just starting school you can use it to write in about the things they say, do, learn at school. If you have an older student, let them write in it. You could even write a few journaling prompts in it to get them started. This is a great place to write down all your child's accomplishments throughout the year!

### Directions:

1. Choose several Chipboard Shapes to embellish the front.
2. Use star Shape to write school year on with permanent pen.
3. Use pencil Shape to write grade level on.
4. Add a 3D Publisher sticker to the pre-printed label on cover for an initial.
5. If you would like to add page dividers to the book simply trim patterned paper to approximately 4.75" x 7". Round the outside corners and adhere to paper inside journal.
6. Tie Mini Sashes onto elastic band for a flirty look.

Project: Booklet  
Title: All About Me  
Skill Level: Beginner to Intermediate

### Description:

Starting a new school year can be a frightening experience for both the child and parent. Breathe a little easier knowing that your contact information and any other information you feel is important is at an arm's reach to your child. So if they can't think of the answer they can find it. This will attach easily inside the front pocket of your child's backpack.

### Directions:

1. Use template on following page to fill in or create your own 2.5" x 3" cards.
2. Print out cards and trim.
3. Cover the backside of each card with patterned paper you have left over from previous projects.
4. Round corners with punch.
5. Add School Days Titles rub-ons to cards to embellish.
6. Punch hole in top corner of each card and attach together with a metal ring.
7. Add Chipboard Shapes to front card and write 'all about me!'.
8. Tie a couple Mini Sashes onto metal ring for fun.
