### Masquerade Halloween Mask

#### SUPPLIES

Scary Strips Glitter Cardstock  
Pumpkin Party Glitter Cardstock  
Skull Soiree Patterned Cardstock  
Cobwebs Patterned Cardstock  
Wicked Icons Glitter Stickers  
Wicked Rub-Ons  
Wicked Softies  
Wicked Badges  
Wicked Sashes

#### DIRECTIONS

First, create a template on a piece of plain white paper to later be used to trace all masks. Using a pencil, lightly sketch out a mask shape (approximately 8" wide and 4" tall). To get the mask even on each side, fold the paper/mask sketch down the middle and cut it out, following the sketch on one side. Unfold the mask and sketch on an eye. Fold again and cut out the eye with a craft knife, going through both layers of the fold. This will ensure that the eyes are cut evenly on either side of the mask. This is your template.

#### ORANGE SPIDER WEB MASK

1. Place the template on top of patterned paper and lightly trace the outline of the mask. Since the center of the spider web ended up being in the center of where that eye would go, only the one eye was cut out, leaving the web to be highlighted. Cut out the remainder of the mask.
2. Place spider web rub-on on the top right corner.
3. Next, cut a piece of paper that is approximately 0.5"x3". Cut thin strips into it, leaving the one end intact. To create the curly effect, tightly wrap the thin paper strips around a pencil one by one. Use glue to attach to the corner of the eye.
4. Next, freehand the feathers and cut out with scissors, lightly fold down the middle. **Optional:** sew a straight line down the middle of the feather with a sewing machine. Adhere to the back side of the mask.
5. **Optional:** Sew a border around entire mask, as well as the cut out for the eye.

6. Next, time to attach the ribbon. This will be used to tie the mask up. Punch a hole (with a regular hole punch) and tie ribbon through the hole.
7. Finish off by accenting with a ghost softie.

#### BLACK MASK

1. Place the template on top of patterned paper and lightly trace the outline of the mask. Instead of using the eyes that were previously cut out on the template, freehand some 'x' shapes and cut out with a craft knife.
2. Place Wicked Icons Glitter Stickers on either side of mask, letting the sticker go over the edge. Trim off overlapping sticker with scissors.
3. Next, cut a piece of paper that is approximately 1.5" x 5", cut strips into it, leaving one end intact. To create the curly effect, tightly wrap the thin paper strips around a pencil one by one. Adhere to the back side of the mask. Repeat for the other side.
4. **Optional:** Sew a border around entire mask.
5. Next, time to attach the ribbon. This will be used to tie the mask up. Punch a hole (with a regular hole punch) and tie ribbon through the hole.
6. Finish off by accenting with an eyeball softie and an eyeball Wicked Badge.

#### ORANGE/YELLOW PUMPKIN MASK

1. Place the template on top of patterned paper and lightly trace the outline of the mask. For this one, try mixing it up and tracing it upside down.
2. Cut a piece of paper approximately 0.5"x1." Using scissors, cut strips into it. These will be the eyelashes. Glue onto mask along the top side of the eye. Repeat for the other side.
3. Cut a piece of paper approximately 1.5"x3". Using scissors, cut strips into it, leaving the one end intact. Adhere to back side of mask. Repeat for the other side.
4. **Optional:** Sew a border around entire mask, and the eyes.
5. Next, attach the ribbon. This will be used to tie up the mask. Punch a hole (with a regular hole punch) and tie ribbon through the hole.
6. Finish off by accenting with 'scary' Wicked Badge.
